What is Tucson Synchro? Tucson Synchro is a non-profit synchronized swimming team of girls ages 7 to 18. It was started in 1972 by Coach Candy Kaemerer whose love and devotion for 45 years has helped foster competition, drive and team work in girls as they compete at State, Regional and National levels. The sport encourages a lifetime of self-discipline, good self-esteem and health long after their pool time is over. **Tucson Synchro** also gives these young ladies a chance to travel and see the country and even some parts of the world which many would not have the opportunity to do on their own...



WHY FUND RAISE: The team typically competes in 3 State competitions plus a Regional, Zone and usually 1 National competition each year. Most of these require hotel, food, entry fees and sometimes airline tickets. Last year's National competition was in Riverside, CA. This year will be in Oxford, OH at Miami University., a bit further and probably more expensive! Most of the money they raise for these events comes from water shows, raffle ticket sales, Gaslight Theater night, swim-a-thon and sponsorships such as Tucson Conquistadors. This year we are putting on our 9th Golf Outing at Arizona National Golf Club.



What is Synchronized Swimming and why is it important? Synchronized swimming is a hybrid form of swimming, dance and gymnastics, consisting of swimmers (either solos, duets, trios or teams) performing a synchronized routine of elaborate moves in the water, accompanied by music. Synchronized swimming demands advanced water skills, and requires great strength, endurance, flexibility, grace, artistry and precise timing, as well as exceptional breath control. (Wikipedia) The United States has produced Olympic grade synchronized swimmers that have gone on to represent the U.S. and win gold, silver and bronze between the years 1984 thru 2004. **Tucson Synchro** helped Alison Bartosik get her start and go on to win bronze in both Team and Duet in the 2004 Athens Olympics. Likewise this year in the Rio Olympics the United States had a duet compete and they ended up 9th overall.
